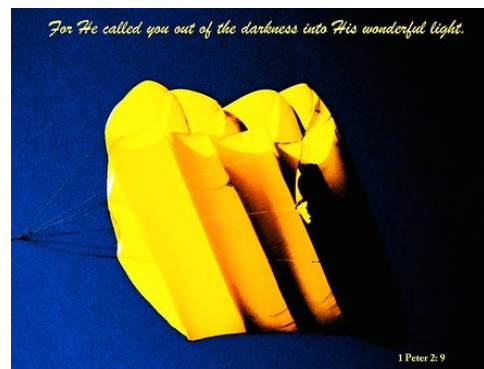

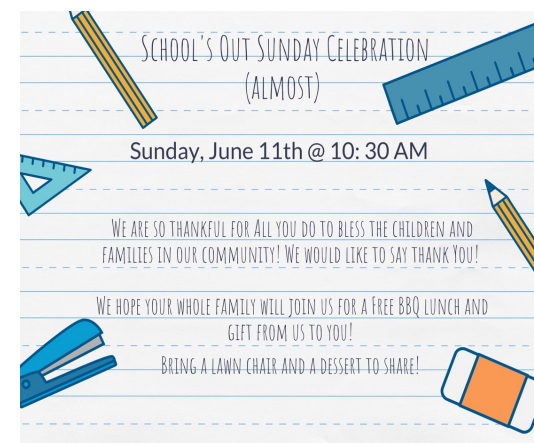

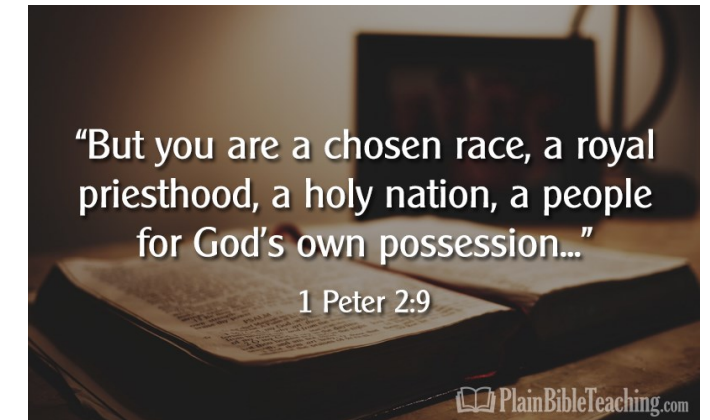
gotsneakers?
